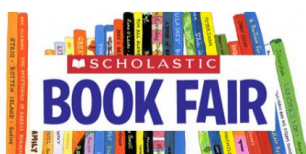


### Autism Awareness Day – Inside Out Day

In support of students with Autism, we are asking students to wear their shirts inside out on Friday, April 13.

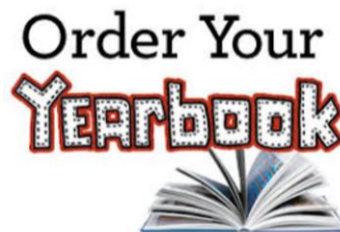
### Kids Eat Smart Breakfast Program
